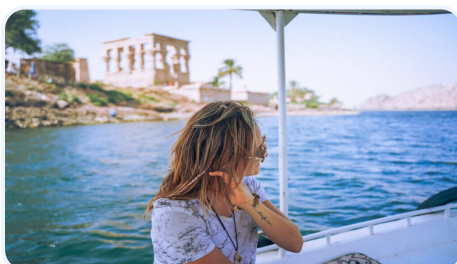
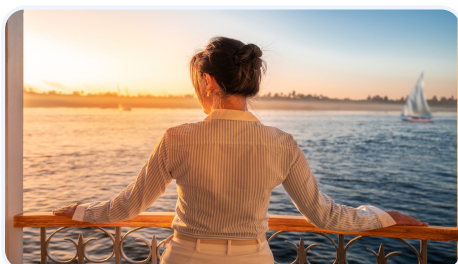
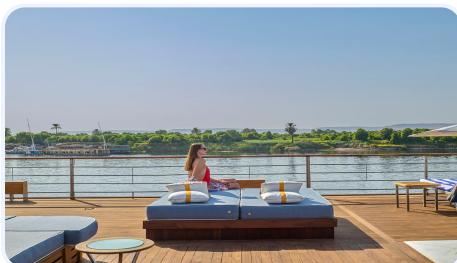

Important to Know

Cruise Amenities & Accommodation :

- Our Nile cruise packages feature four exceptional vessel categories: 5-Star Standard, 5-Star Deluxe, 5-Star Ultra Deluxe, and 5-Star Luxury. Ships feature spacious double cabins, single cabins, and suites. Main and upper deck cabins offer large panoramic sliding windows. Onboard amenities include 24-hour reception, Wi-Fi and laundry service with extra charge, an expansive sun deck with a swimming pool and pool bar.
- Cabins feature individually controlled air conditioning, satellite TV, private en-suite bathroom with shower and hairdryer, mini-bar, and in-room safe box.

Extra fees to be paid on-site:

- Entrance tickets to the Tomb of Tutankhamun require a fee of around 700 EGP for adults and 350 EGP for children under 12. Payment is available only with credit cards
- Entrance fee to the Tomb of Ramses VI is around 220 EGP for adults and 110 EGP for children under 12. Payment is available only with credit cards
- The tour of Abu Simbel Temple and the Sound and Light Shows are not included in the price and are available for booking online instantly or by paying cash to your Journey To Egypt tour guide upon arrival on board

Know in advance:

- Prices are quoted in US Dollars per person per trip, except during Christmas, New Year & Easter holidays (From 20th December to 2nd January (Christmas), and the 28th of March to the 17th of April (Easter))
- The price is based on a standard double cabin (for 2 persons aged 12–80 years) located on the main deck and includes the sightseeing package as well as full board accommodation (drinks are not included)
- Infants under 2 years may share the same double cabin free of charge. Kindly ensure that the infant's age is specified during the booking process
- Upper deck cabins are subject to availability and incur a supplement of around USD 15 per person per night. If interested, payment can be made directly on board
- Your entrance ticket to Valley of the Kings includes a visit to 3 tombs, excluding the tombs of Tutankhamun and Ramses VI
- The Nile Cruise package includes all daily transfers between the cruise vessel and scheduled tours, including airport and local transfers
- Check-in to your cabin is at 12PM on the first day, and check-out is at 08AM on the departure day. However, you are welcome to board the cruise upon arrival and relax in the lounge bar until your cabin is ready. Likewise, after check-out, you may continue to use the lounge bar and onboard facilities until your final departure
- Your full board accommodation includes breakfast, lunch, and dinner. The meal plan is structured based on your arrival: If your stay starts with lunch on the first day, it will end with breakfast on the last day

Optional Excursions & Add-Ons

- Luxor Sunrise Hot Air Balloon Tour (Day 2): Experience the Valley of the Kings from above at dawn (\$125 per person). Pickup takes place between 4:30 AM and 5:00 AM directly from your Nile Cruise vessel. The balloon capacity is capped at 25 guests. Please note that professional cameras are prohibited in the basket (mobile phone cameras are permitted). This activity is subject to weather conditions. Speak with your tour guide on Day 1 if you would like to reserve this experience.
- Abu Simbel Day Trip from Aswan (Day 5): You can easily add a morning excursion from Aswan to explore the magnificent temples of Abu Simbel (\$130 per person; 3 hours each way). Contact us in advance to arrange this tour.

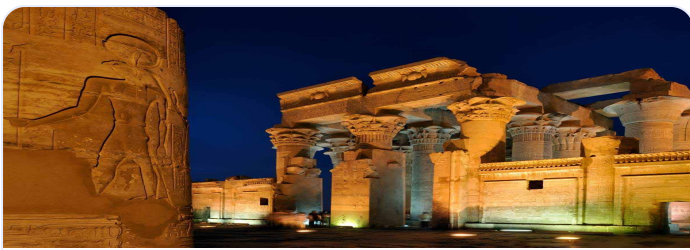

Day By Day Itinerary



Day 1

Arrival in Luxor | The East Bank Temples

Upon arriving at Luxor International Airport, you will be warmly met by your Journey To Egypt team to begin your tour of Egypt's celebrated East Bank. Your first stop is the colossal Karnak Temple, where generations of pharaohs expanded monuments to immortalize their legacies. Walk through the breathtaking Great Hypostyle Hall, strolling amidst 134 towering stone columns that rise up to 80 feet.

Continue to the striking Luxor Temple to admire the grand pylons, colossal statues of Ramses II, and the majestic Colonnade of Amenhotep III. Walk in the footsteps of ancient worshippers before embarking your premier Nile cruise vessel. Savor a freshly prepared lunch and dinner on board as you settle into your cabin.

Included Activities: Private airport arrival transfer, private guided tour of Karnak Temple & Luxor Temple

Day 2

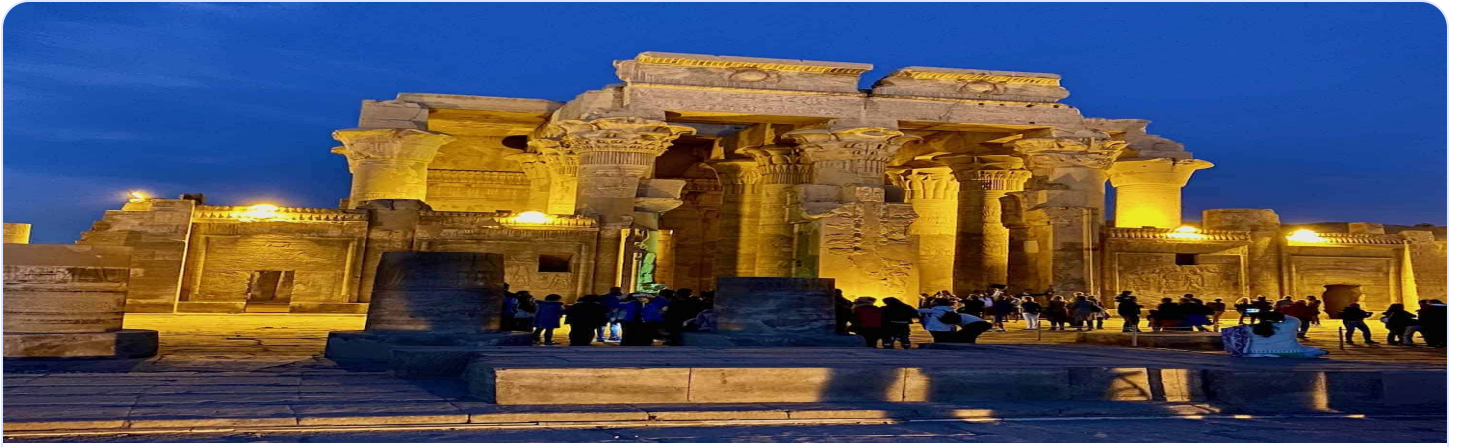
The West Bank & Valley of the Kings | Cruise the Nile

This morning, journey across to Luxor's storied West Bank and the Necropolis of Thebes. Your tour begins in the world-famous Valley of the Kings, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and royal burial ground for Egypt's pharaohs for over five centuries. Explore the ancient tombs at your own pace. (Optional: Step inside the legendary Tomb of Tutankhamun with an on-site ticket purchase).

Next, proceed with your guide to the architecturally stunning Temple of Hatshepsut, dedicated to ancient Egypt's first great female pharaoh. Before returning to the river, stop to admire the massive Colossi of Memnon. In the afternoon, return to your vessel and begin sailing scenic waters toward Edfu.

Included Activities: Private guided tour of Valley of the Kings, Temple of Hatshepsut & Colossi of Memnon

Day 3

Temple of Horus & Kom Ombo Temple | Cruise the Nile

Discover the remarkably preserved Temple of Horus in Edfu, built in 230 BC and dedicated to the falcon-headed sky god. Its vivid carvings offer an extraordinary glimpse into ancient religious rituals.

Return to the ship and cruise south to Kom Ombo to explore its unique dual temple dedicated to Haroeris (the sun god) and Sobek (the crocodile god). View the fascinating mummified remains of ancient crocodiles displayed on-site while your guide explains their historical significance. Re-embark your vessel and continue sailing smoothly toward Aswan.

Included Activities: Private guided visit of Temple of Edfu (Horus) & Kom Ombo Temple

Day 4

Highlights of Aswan | Philae Temple, High Dam & Scenic Felucca Sail

Enjoy a short boat ride across the Nile to Agilika Island for a tour of the enchanted Philae Temple, dedicated to the goddess Isis. This striking sanctuary reflects a magnificent blend of Egyptian, Greek, and Roman architectural influences. Continue to the engineering marvel of the Aswan High Dam.

Later in the afternoon, experience authentic local culture during a private sail around the Aswan islands aboard a traditional wooden felucca while enjoying picturesque sunset views over the Nile.

Included Activities: Private guided tour of Philae Temple & Aswan High Dam, private Nile Felucca excursion

Day 5

Optional Abu Simbel Excursion | Departure from Aswan

Enjoy a relaxing final morning on board, or embark on a captivating early excursion to the monumental Abu Simbel Temples (optional), carved directly into the mountainside by Ramses II. After concluding your sightseeing, enjoy a smooth transfer to Aswan International Airport for your onward flight.
