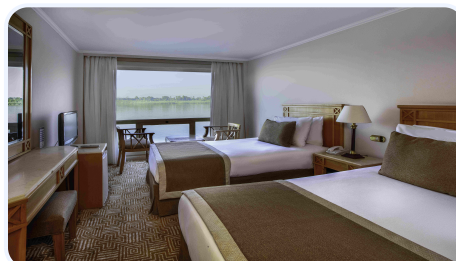
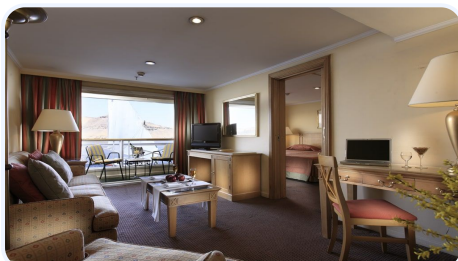

Day By Day Itinerary

04 Days / 03 Nights Program (Every Monday)

Day 1 - Welcome to Aswan: Your Nile Adventure Begins

Your journey begins as you board [Crown Emperor Nile Cruise](#) before lunch in the beautiful city of Aswan. After settling into your comfortable cabin and enjoying your first moments on board, it's time to discover some of the city's most iconic landmarks.

Your first stop is the impressive [High Dam](#), one of Egypt's greatest modern engineering achievements. Built to regulate the flow of the Nile and generate electricity across the country, it also offers spectacular panoramic views over the peaceful waters of Lake Nasser.

Next, take a short motorboat ride to the enchanting [Philae Temple](#), beautifully situated on Agilkia Island. Dedicated to the goddess Isis, this remarkable sanctuary is admired for its elegant columns, intricate carvings, and romantic island setting that makes it one of the most picturesque temples in Egypt.

Continue your exploration with a visit to the [Unfinished Obelisk](#), where you'll discover the ancient granite quarries and learn how the ancient Egyptians carved massive monuments directly from the bedrock.

Return to the cruise for dinner before spending a peaceful overnight stay onboard in Aswan.

Day 2 - Optional Abu Simbel & The Twin Temple of Kom Ombo

For those wishing to discover one of Egypt's greatest archaeological treasures, the day begins with an [optional](#) early morning excursion to [Abu Simbel](#) by road or domestic flight ([available at an additional cost](#)).

Marvel at the magnificent Abu Simbel Temples, where the colossal monuments of Ramesses II and Queen Nefertari stand proudly carved into a sandstone cliff overlooking Lake Nasser. These extraordinary temples are masterpieces of ancient engineering and were famously relocated during UNESCO's rescue campaign following the construction of the High Dam.

After returning to your cruise, relax as the ship sails north towards Kom Ombo, allowing you to admire the ever-changing scenery of the Nile.

Later in the afternoon, visit the fascinating [Kom Ombo Temple](#), the only double temple in ancient Egypt dedicated to both Sobek, the crocodile god, and Horus the Elder. Explore beautifully preserved reliefs illustrating ancient medical instruments before visiting the small museum, where a remarkable collection of mummified crocodiles reveals the importance of Sobek in ancient Egyptian beliefs.

Dinner is served onboard as the cruise continues its scenic journey toward Edfu.

Day 3 - From Edfu to the Wonders of Luxor

Begin the morning with a traditional [horse-drawn carriage](#) ride through Edfu, leading you to one of Egypt's finest preserved ancient monuments.

Explore the magnificent [Temple of Horus](#), considered one of the best-preserved temples in the country. As you walk through its massive gateways, sacred halls, and beautifully decorated chambers, discover the legendary battle between Horus and Seth, vividly illustrated across the temple walls.

After your visit, return to the cruise and continue sailing toward Luxor, enjoying lunch while the timeless scenery of Upper Egypt unfolds along the Nile.

Upon arrival in Luxor, your afternoon is dedicated to exploring the spectacular [Karnak Temple Complex](#), the largest religious complex ever built in the ancient world. Wander among colossal statues, sacred lakes, towering obelisks, and the famous Great Hypostyle Hall, home to 134 massive columns that remain one of Egypt's greatest architectural achievements.

The journey continues at the magnificent [Luxor Temple](#), beautifully illuminated as the sun begins to set. Located in the heart of the city, the temple's giant statues, graceful colonnades, and impressive obelisks create an unforgettable evening atmosphere.

Return to the cruise for dinner and your overnight stay in Luxor.

Day 4 - Discover the West Bank of Luxor & Farewell

Enjoy breakfast onboard before checking out and setting off to explore the legendary West Bank of Luxor, home to some of ancient Egypt's most remarkable royal monuments.

Your first destination is the famous [Valley of the Kings](#), where generations of pharaohs were laid to rest in elaborately decorated tombs hidden beneath the desert mountains. Your visit includes entry to three royal tombs, while access to Tutankhamun's Tomb is available with an [additional ticket](#).

Continue to the breathtaking [Temple of Queen Hatshepsut](#), a unique architectural masterpiece rising gracefully against the

towering limestone cliffs of Deir el-Bahari. Built to honor Egypt's most powerful female ruler, the temple remains one of the country's most iconic monuments.

Before concluding your journey, stop at the impressive **Colossi of Memnon**, two enormous statues of Amenhotep III that have watched over the Theban Necropolis for thousands of years.

After your visit, your unforgettable Nile Cruise experience comes to an end.

Day 1 - Welcome to Luxor & Discover the East Bank

Your unforgettable Nile journey begins as you board **Crown Emperor Nile Cruise** before lunch in the magnificent city of Luxor. After receiving a warm welcome from the crew and settling into your comfortable cabin, prepare to explore two of the greatest temples ever built in ancient Egypt.

Your afternoon starts at the breathtaking **Karnak Temple Complex**, an enormous religious sanctuary covering more than 100 hectares. Walk through the impressive Avenue of Ram-Headed Sphinxes before reaching the massive First Pylon, then continue into the legendary Great Hypostyle Hall, where 134 towering columns decorated with intricate hieroglyphics create one of Egypt's most spectacular architectural masterpieces. As you continue your visit, discover sacred lakes, majestic obelisks, and the vast Precinct of Amun-Re, where over 1,500 years of history come together in one extraordinary complex.

Continue to the elegant **Luxor Temple**, beautifully illuminated by the afternoon sunlight. Once dedicated to the renewal of kingship, the temple showcases the colossal statues of Ramesses II, the historic Abu Haggag Mosque built within its walls, and the famous Avenue of Sphinxes, which once connected Luxor Temple with Karnak.

After your tour, return to the cruise to enjoy afternoon tea on the sun deck while watching the Nile flow peacefully by. Dinner is served onboard before spending your first overnight stay in Luxor.

Day 2 - The Royal Necropolis & Sailing Through Esna

Wake up to another beautiful morning on the Nile before setting off to discover the legendary treasures of Luxor's West Bank.

Your adventure begins in the world-famous **Valley of the Kings**, where Egypt's greatest pharaohs prepared their eternal resting places deep inside the Theban mountains. Visit three beautifully decorated royal tombs, while **optional** entrance to the **tombs of Tutankhamun or Seti I** is available for those wishing to explore even further.

Next, continue to the remarkable **Temple of Queen Hatshepsut**, an architectural masterpiece built into the limestone cliffs of Deir el-Bahari. Its elegant terraces, magnificent colonnades, and beautifully preserved reliefs celebrate the reign of Egypt's first great female pharaoh.

Your final stop is the impressive **Colossi of Memnon**, the two gigantic statues of Amenhotep III that once guarded one of ancient Egypt's largest mortuary temples. Hear the fascinating stories behind the legendary "singing statues" that captured the imagination of ancient travelers.

Return to the cruise for lunch before beginning your scenic sail toward Esna. Watch traditional villages, fertile farmland, and daily life unfold along the Nile before experiencing the fascinating passage through the historic Esna Lock. Dinner is served onboard as the cruise continues sailing toward Edfu.

Optional Hot Air Balloon Ride

For an unforgettable start to your morning, choose an optional Hot Air Balloon excursion over Luxor. As the sun rises above the Nile, drift peacefully across the sky while enjoying breathtaking panoramic views of the Valley of the Kings, ancient temples, lush farmland, and the timeless landscape of ancient Thebes.

Day 3 - The Temples of Horus & Kom Ombo

Arrive in Edfu, where a traditional horse-drawn carriage carries you through the town to one of Egypt's finest surviving temples.

Step inside the magnificent **Temple of Horus**, regarded as the best-preserved temple from the ancient world. Built during the Ptolemaic Period, this remarkable monument honors Horus, the falcon-headed god of kingship and protection. Wander through its monumental entrance, spacious courtyards, beautifully carved reliefs depicting the battle between Horus and Seth, and the sacred sanctuary where ancient religious rituals once took place.

Return to the cruise and enjoy lunch onboard while sailing toward Kom Ombo.

Later in the afternoon, visit the unique **Kom Ombo Temple**, one of Egypt's most distinctive temples thanks to its perfectly symmetrical twin design. One side is dedicated to Sobek, the crocodile god and guardian of the Nile, while the other honors Horus the Elder, god of the sky and kingship. Discover remarkable carvings of ancient surgical instruments, calendars, and healing rituals before continuing to the nearby **Crocodile Mummification Museum**, where preserved crocodile mummies reveal the sacred role these animals once played in ancient Egyptian religion.

Return to the cruise for dinner as your peaceful voyage continues toward Aswan.

Dedicated to Isis, the goddess of love and magic, this elegant temple is admired for its graceful columns, beautifully preserved sanctuaries, and peaceful island setting that makes it one of Egypt's most captivating archaeological sites.

The journey continues to the ancient granite quarries, where you'll visit the enormous **Unfinished Obelisk**. Still attached to the bedrock, this unfinished monument offers a fascinating insight into the incredible stone-working techniques mastered by the ancient Egyptians.

Return to the cruise for lunch before enjoying a relaxing afternoon onboard, or choose an optional Felucca Sailing experience on the Nile.

Optional Nubian Village Visit

You may also choose to visit one of Aswan's traditional Nubian villages, reached by boat along the Nile. Wander through colorful mud-brick homes decorated with vibrant artwork, meet welcoming local families, and discover the unique customs, music, traditions, and lifestyle that make Nubian culture one of Egypt's richest cultural treasures.

Alongside the beautiful temple dedicated to Queen Nefertari, these extraordinary monuments represent one of the greatest achievements of ancient Egyptian architecture. Following the construction of the High Dam, both temples were carefully relocated through UNESCO's remarkable rescue project, preserving them for future generations.

This unforgettable visit offers the perfect ending to your Nile adventure before continuing your onward journey.
