4 Nights: Every Saturday from Luxor to Aswan

Day 1: Welcome to Luxor - East Bank Exploration

Your Kon Tiki Nile Cruise journey begins in Luxor, the world's greatest open-air museum. Embark on board before lunch, where you will be welcomed with traditional hospitality. Take time to settle into your cabin and enjoy your first moments sailing along the legendary Nile River.

In the afternoon, begin your exploration of Luxor's East Bank:

Karnak Temple Complex

Discover the magnificent Karnak Temple Complex, one of the largest religious sites ever built and a masterpiece dedicated to Amun-Re. Walk along the impressive Avenue of Ram-Headed Sphinxes leading to the First Pylon, then explore the legendary Great Hypostyle Hall with its 134 towering columns covered with ancient inscriptions. Continue your journey through sacred lakes, towering obelisks, and the Precinct of Amun-Re, uncovering layers of history that span more than 1,500 years.

Luxor Temple

Visit the beautiful Luxor Temple, a remarkable monument that was once a center for divine rejuvenation ceremonies. Admire the colossal statues of Ramses II, explore the remains of the Abu Haggag Mosque built within the temple complex, and discover the continuation of the ancient Sphinx Avenue that once connected Luxor Temple with Karnak.

Return to the cruise for tea time and relaxation on the sun deck. Enjoy dinner onboard and spend the night in Luxor.

Day 2: Luxor West Bank - Royal Tombs & Temples | Sail to Esna

After breakfast, continue your journey through ancient Thebes and explore the legendary West Bank of Luxor, home to the tombs and temples of Egypt's greatest rulers.

Valley of the Kings

Step into the hidden world of the pharaohs and explore the royal tombs carved deep into the Theban cliffs. Visit three beautifully decorated tombs, where colorful scenes reveal ancient Egyptian beliefs about the afterlife. Optional entrance to the tombs of Tutankhamun or Seti I is available at an additional cost.

Temple of Queen Hatshepsut

Discover the extraordinary Temple of Queen Hatshepsut at Deir El-Bahari, an architectural masterpiece built into the limestone cliffs. Admire its elegant terraces, detailed reliefs, impressive colonnades, and panoramic views overlooking the ancient necropolis.

Colossi of Memnon

Continue to the two magnificent statues of Pharaoh Amenhotep III, which once guarded the entrance of his enormous mortuary temple. Learn about the legends surrounding the famous “singing statues” of ancient times.

Return to the cruise for lunch onboard and begin sailing south toward Esna. Enjoy views of charming villages and green landscapes along the Nile while passing through the Esna Lock.

Enjoy dinner and overnight onboard while sailing toward Edfu.

Optional Hot Air Balloon

Experience the magic of Luxor from above with an early morning hot air balloon ride (extra cost). As the sun rises over the Nile, float peacefully above the Valley of the Kings, ancient temples, and fertile farmlands while enjoying a breathtaking panoramic view of ancient Thebes surrounded by golden morning light.

Day 3: Temples of Horus & Sobek - From Edfu to Kom Ombo

Continue your Nile adventure with a morning visit to the impressive Temple of Horus at Edfu. Reach the temple by traditional horse-drawn carriage, creating a memorable experience that recalls the charm of 19th-century travel.

Temple of Horus at Edfu

Explore one of the best-preserved temples in Egypt, built during the Ptolemaic period and dedicated to Horus, the falcon-headed god of kingship and protection. Walk through the massive entrance pylon, admire the grand courtyards, study the detailed reliefs depicting the battle between Horus and Seth, and enter the Holy of Holies where ancient rituals were once performed.

Return to the cruise and enjoy lunch onboard while sailing toward Kom Ombo.

Temple of Kom Ombo

Visit the unique double temple of Kom Ombo, a perfectly symmetrical structure dedicated to two gods. One side honors Sobek, the crocodile god and protector of the Nile, while the other side is dedicated to Horus the Elder, the god of kingship and the sky.

Explore the fascinating medical instruments carved into the temple walls, the ancient calendar, and the remarkable stories connected with healing and ancient Egyptian medicine.

Crocodile Mummification Museum

Visit the Crocodile Mummification Museum and discover the ancient traditions surrounding the sacred crocodiles of Kom Ombo.

Return to the cruise for dinner and continue sailing toward Aswan.

Day 4: Aswan - Nubian Charm & Modern Marvels

High Dam

Visit the Aswan High Dam, a modern engineering achievement that transformed Egypt by controlling the Nile floods and providing electricity and irrigation for millions. Enjoy spectacular views over Lake Nasser from this impressive landmark.

Temple of Philae

Travel by boat to Agilkia Island to explore the enchanting Temple of Philae, dedicated to Isis, the goddess of love and magic. Carefully relocated stone by stone during the UNESCO rescue project, the temple remains one of Egypt's most beautiful monuments with its elegant columns, sacred sanctuaries, and peaceful lakeside setting.

Unfinished Obelisk

Discover the ancient granite quarries of Aswan and see the largest obelisk ever attempted, still lying unfinished in the ground. This unique site reveals the incredible craftsmanship and techniques used by ancient Egyptian builders.

Return to the cruise for lunch onboard. Enjoy free time in the afternoon or choose an optional felucca sailing experience. Dinner and overnight onboard in Aswan.

Optional Nubian Village Visit

Discover the colorful traditions of the Nubian people with a visit to one of Aswan's traditional villages (extra cost). Travel by boat along the Nile, explore vibrant mud-brick homes, meet welcoming locals, and learn about Nubian customs, music, and lifestyle. This cultural experience offers a wonderful glimpse into the heritage of southern Egypt.

These magnificent monuments were relocated through an extraordinary UNESCO rescue project and remain a timeless symbol of ancient Egyptian engineering, devotion, and grandeur.

In the afternoon, begin exploring the highlights of Aswan:

High Dam

Visit this impressive engineering achievement that transformed Egypt's modern history by controlling the Nile's flow and providing electricity throughout the country. Enjoy breathtaking views over Lake Nasser from this remarkable site.

Philae Temple

Travel by motorboat to the beautiful island of Agilkia to discover Philae Temple, dedicated to the goddess Isis. Surrounded by the peaceful waters of the Nile, the temple's detailed carvings and romantic island setting make it one of Egypt's most enchanting ancient sites.

Unfinished Obelisk

Day 2: Abu Simbel (Optional) - Kom Ombo Temple

Abu Simbel Temples

Explore the magnificent temples of Ramses II and Queen Nefertari, carved directly into the sandstone cliffs overlooking Lake Nasser. These extraordinary monuments represent one of ancient Egypt's greatest achievements and were carefully relocated through a UNESCO project to save them from the rising waters after the construction of the High Dam.

After returning to the cruise, continue sailing north toward Kom Ombo.

Kom Ombo Temple

Visit the unique double temple dedicated to Sobek, the crocodile god, and Horus the Elder. Discover its fascinating medical reliefs and visit the small museum displaying ancient crocodile mummies.

Return to the cruise and enjoy dinner while sailing toward Edfu.

Day 3: Edfu Temple - Luxor East Bank

Temple of Horus at Edfu

Return to the cruise and enjoy lunch onboard while sailing toward Luxor.

Karnak Temple Complex

Discover the largest religious complex of the ancient world, dedicated to Amun-Re. Walk among colossal statues, explore the famous Great Hypostyle Hall with its 134 towering columns, and admire the sacred lakes and monuments that reveal thousands of years of history.

Luxor Temple

Visit the stunning temple of Queen Hatshepsut, built into the limestone cliffs of Deir El Bahari. This remarkable monument honors one of Egypt's most powerful female rulers and showcases unique architectural design.

Colossi of Memnon

End your Luxor sightseeing with a visit to the two massive statues of Amenhotep III, which once stood as guardians of his great mortuary temple.
