5 Days from Luxor to Aswan (Every Saturday)

Day 1 - Saturday: Luxor

Embarkation begins in Luxor, the ancient city of pharaohs. After a delicious lunch onboard, you'll visit the spectacular Luxor Temple and the sprawling Karnak Temple. Enjoy dinner onboard as the boat sails along the west bank for an overnight stay, surrounded by stunning views.

Early morning sailing brings you to Gebel El Silsila and breakfast onboard. Visit the fascinating Kom Ombo Temple before heading to El Sheikh Fadi Island. Enjoy tea, dinner, and a relaxing evening on the island before sailing to Aswan for the night.

Day 5 - Wednesday: Aswan

Day 1 - Wednesday: Aswan

Day 3 - Friday: Sail to Luxor

Sail to Esna after breakfast, cross the Esna Lock, and head towards Luxor. Visit the Luxor and Karnak Temples on the East Bank, followed by a relaxing dinner onboard. Overnight will be spent on the Luxor West Bank.

Day 4 - Saturday: West Bank of Luxor & Disembarkation

Your final day includes visits to the Valley of the Kings, Hatshepsut Temple, and the Colossi of Memnon before disembarkation in Luxor.
