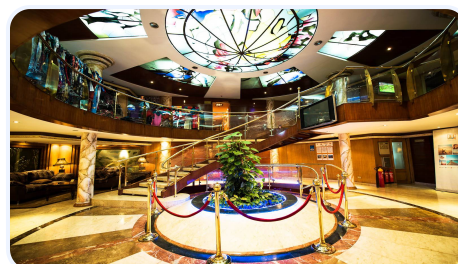
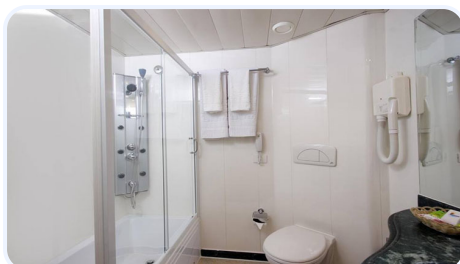

Day By Day Itinerary

4 Nights: Every Monday from Luxor to Aswan

Day 1 – Welcome to Luxor & Explore the East Bank

Your Journey to Egypt adventure begins with a warm welcome in Luxor, where our representative will assist you with your transfer to the cruise before lunch. After settling into your comfortable cabin and enjoying your first meal onboard, it's time to discover two of Egypt's most spectacular ancient temples.

Start your sightseeing at the magnificent **Karnak Temple Complex**, the largest religious complex ever built. Walk among towering columns, sacred lakes, colossal statues, and beautifully carved obelisks that tell the story of over 2,000 years of ancient Egyptian history.

Continue to the elegant **Luxor Temple**, beautifully situated along the Nile. Built primarily by Amenhotep III and Ramses II, this remarkable temple comes alive in the afternoon light and offers an unforgettable introduction to ancient Thebes.

Return to the cruise to relax on the sun deck before enjoying dinner and your first overnight stay in Luxor.

Day 2 – Discover the West Bank & Sail Along the Nile

After breakfast, begin your exploration of Luxor's legendary West Bank, home to some of Egypt's most treasured archaeological sites.

Visit the famous **Valley of the Kings**, where generations of pharaohs were buried inside richly decorated tombs hidden beneath the desert mountains. Continue to the breathtaking **Temple of Queen Hatshepsut**, an architectural masterpiece built against dramatic limestone cliffs, before stopping at the impressive **Colossi of Memnon**, two massive statues that have watched over the Theban Necropolis for thousands of years.

Return to the cruise for lunch as your ship begins sailing south through the Esna Lock. Spend the afternoon relaxing on deck while enjoying the peaceful scenery of the Nile, passing traditional villages, fertile farmland, and palm-lined riverbanks.

For an unforgettable experience, you may choose the optional sunrise Hot Air Balloon ride over Luxor before the day's sightseeing.

Dinner and overnight onboard while sailing toward Edfu.

Day 3 – Edfu & Kom Ombo Temples

This morning, travel by traditional horse-drawn carriage to the remarkable **Temple of Horus at Edfu**, one of the best-preserved temples in all of Egypt. Dedicated to the falcon-headed god Horus, the temple's impressive entrance, detailed carvings,

and grand halls offer a fascinating glimpse into the Ptolemaic era.

Return to the cruise and continue sailing toward Kom Ombo while enjoying lunch onboard.

In the afternoon, visit the unique **Temple of Kom Ombo**, perfectly designed with two identical halves dedicated to Sobek, the crocodile god, and Horus the Elder. Explore its beautifully preserved reliefs before visiting the nearby Crocodile Museum, home to fascinating mummified crocodiles discovered in the area.

Continue sailing toward Aswan while enjoying dinner and another peaceful evening onboard.

Day 4 – Discover the Beauty of Aswan

After breakfast, explore the highlights of beautiful Aswan, Egypt's southern gateway.

Visit the impressive **High Dam**, one of the country's greatest modern engineering achievements, before taking a short motorboat ride to the enchanting **Temple of Philae**, dedicated to the goddess Isis and beautifully relocated to Agilkia Island.

Continue to the ancient granite quarries to see the enormous **Unfinished Obelisk**, providing valuable insight into the incredible stone-working techniques of ancient Egyptian craftsmen.

Return to the cruise for lunch and spend the afternoon relaxing onboard. Guests may also join the optional excursion to a colorful Nubian Village to experience the culture, traditions, and hospitality of southern Egypt.

Dinner and overnight onboard in Aswan.

Day 5 – Farewell Aswan

Enjoy a leisurely breakfast onboard before disembarking in Aswan.

Guests wishing to extend their adventure can join the optional early morning excursion to the magnificent **Abu Simbel Temples**, where the colossal temples of Ramses II and Queen Nefertari stand proudly overlooking Lake Nasser after their remarkable UNESCO relocation.

Your unforgettable Journey to Egypt experience concludes with your transfer to Aswan Airport, train station, or hotel.

3 Nights: Every Thursday from Aswan to Luxor

Day 1 – Welcome to Aswan

Upon arrival in Aswan, our representative will welcome you and transfer you to your Nile Cruise before lunch. After checking into your cabin and enjoying your first meal onboard, begin exploring one of Egypt's most charming cities.

Visit the impressive **High Dam**, followed by a scenic boat ride to the beautiful **Temple of Philae**, dedicated to Isis and surrounded by the tranquil waters of the Nile. Continue to the nearby granite quarries to admire the gigantic **Unfinished Obelisk**, revealing how ancient Egyptians crafted these enormous monuments.

Return to the cruise for dinner and your first overnight stay in Aswan.

Day 2 – Abu Simbel (Optional) & Kom Ombo
