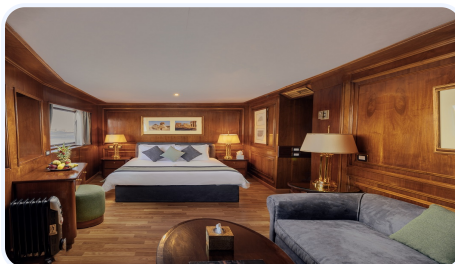

4 Days / 3 Nights Program (Every Wednesday from Aswan)

Day 1 - Wednesday | Welcome to Aswan & Begin Your Nile Adventure

Your unforgettable journey begins in **Aswan**, where you'll board **Salacia Nile Cruise** before lunch and settle into your elegant suite. After embarkation, set out to discover the city's most famous landmarks.

Visit the impressive **Aswan High Dam**, one of Egypt's greatest engineering achievements, offering spectacular views over the vast waters of **Lake Nasser**. Continue by motorboat to the enchanting **Philae Temple**, beautifully located on **Agilkia Island** and dedicated to the goddess **Isis**. Surrounded by the tranquil waters of the Nile, this remarkable sanctuary is admired for its graceful architecture and beautifully preserved reliefs.

Complete your sightseeing with a visit to the remarkable **Unfinished Obelisk**, where you'll learn how ancient Egyptian craftsmen carved massive granite monuments directly from the bedrock.

Return to the cruise for dinner and enjoy your first peaceful evening aboard in Aswan.

Overnight aboard in Aswan

Day 2 - Thursday | Optional Abu Simbel & Kom Ombo Temple

For those wishing to experience one of Egypt's greatest archaeological treasures, an **optional early morning excursion to Abu Simbel** is available by road or domestic flight (additional cost).

Discover the magnificent **Temples of Abu Simbel**, built by **Ramesses II** in honor of himself and **Queen Nefertari**. Carved directly into the sandstone cliffs overlooking **Lake Nasser**, these monumental temples were carefully relocated during UNESCO's famous rescue project following the construction of the High Dam.

Return to the cruise and begin sailing north toward **Kom Ombo** while enjoying lunch onboard.

In the afternoon, visit the fascinating **Temple of Kom Ombo**, uniquely dedicated to both **Sobek**, the crocodile god, and **Horus the Elder**. Explore its remarkable reliefs, ancient medical carvings, and the nearby **Crocodile Museum**, home to a fascinating collection of mummified crocodiles.

Return to the cruise for dinner as you continue sailing toward **Edfu**.

Overnight aboard while sailing to Edfu

Day 3 - Friday | Edfu Temple & Luxor East Bank

After breakfast, travel by traditional horse-drawn carriage through the streets of **Edfu** to visit the magnificent **Temple of Horus**, one of the best-preserved temples in all of Egypt.

Dedicated to the falcon-headed god **Horus**, this extraordinary temple features towering entrance pylons, beautifully decorated halls, sacred chambers, and impressive reliefs illustrating the legendary battle between Horus and Seth.

Return to the cruise and continue sailing toward **Luxor**, enjoying lunch onboard while taking in the peaceful scenery of the Nile.

Upon arrival, begin exploring the treasures of **Luxor's East Bank**. Visit the magnificent **Karnak Temple Complex**, the largest religious site ever built in ancient Egypt. Wander through its colossal statues, admire the breathtaking **Great Hypostyle Hall** with its 134 towering columns, and discover the sacred lakes dedicated to **Amun-Re**.

Continue to the elegant **Luxor Temple**, beautifully illuminated as the afternoon light fades. Admire its impressive statues, towering obelisks, and magnificent courtyards that have welcomed kings and pilgrims for thousands of years.

Enjoy your final breakfast onboard before checking out and setting off to explore the legendary **West Bank of Luxor**.

Discover the world-famous **Valley of the Kings**, where generations of pharaohs were buried inside beautifully decorated tombs hidden beneath the Theban hills. Your visit includes entry to three royal tombs, with the opportunity to visit **Tutankhamun's Tomb** for an additional charge.

Continue to the spectacular **Temple of Queen Hatshepsut**, dramatically built into the limestone cliffs of **Deir El Bahari**, before stopping at the iconic **Colossi of Memnon**, the two enormous statues of **Amenhotep III** that have stood guard for more than three thousand years.

After the tour, your unforgettable Nile cruise comes to an end with disembarkation in Luxor.

Day 1 - Saturday | Welcome to Luxor & Explore the East Bank

Your Nile adventure begins in the timeless city of **Luxor**, where you'll board **Salacia Nile Cruise** before lunch and be welcomed aboard with warm hospitality. After settling into your elegant suite and enjoying lunch, begin your journey through the wonders of ancient Egypt with a visit to Luxor's magnificent East Bank.

Explore the breathtaking **Karnak Temple Complex**, the largest religious complex ever built in ancient Egypt. Your visit includes entry to three royal tombs, while optional visits to the famous **Tutankhamun's Tomb** or **Seti I's Tomb** are available for an additional charge.

Continue to the magnificent **Temple of Queen Hatshepsut**, dramatically rising from the limestone cliffs of **Deir El Bahari**, before stopping at the iconic **Colossi of Memnon**, the massive statues of **Amenhotep III** that have watched over the Theban Necropolis for thousands of years.

Return to the cruise for lunch before sailing south toward **Esna**. Relax on the sun deck as the scenery changes from bustling towns to peaceful riverside villages, then experience the fascinating passage through the historic **Esna Lock** before continuing your journey toward **Edfu**.

Guests seeking an unforgettable experience may also join an **optional Hot Air Balloon ride** early this morning, offering breathtaking aerial views over the **Valley of the Kings**, ancient temples, and the lush Nile Valley at sunrise.

Overnight aboard while sailing toward Edfu

Day 3 - Monday | Edfu & Kom Ombo Along the Nile

Wake up to another beautiful morning on the Nile before arriving in [Edfu](#), where a traditional horse-drawn carriage takes you through the town to the magnificent [Temple of Horus](#).

One of the finest preserved temples in Egypt, this remarkable sanctuary is dedicated to [Horus](#), the falcon-headed god of protection and kingship. Admire its towering entrance pylon, spacious courtyards, beautifully carved walls, and sacred chambers that once hosted important religious ceremonies.

Return to the cruise for lunch while sailing toward [Kom Ombo](#).

Later, visit the extraordinary [Temple of Kom Ombo](#), one of Egypt's most unique temples, dedicated equally to [Sobek](#), the crocodile god, and [Horus the Elder](#). Discover fascinating carvings of ancient medical instruments, detailed calendars, and remarkable scenes reflecting the advanced knowledge of ancient Egyptian civilization. Your visit also includes the nearby [Crocodile Mummification Museum](#), where preserved crocodile mummies reveal the importance of Sobek in ancient Egyptian religion.

Return to the cruise and continue sailing peacefully toward [Aswan](#) while dinner is served onboard.

Dedicated to [Isis](#), the goddess of love and magic, this remarkable temple was carefully relocated during UNESCO's famous rescue project and remains one of Egypt's most captivating archaeological sites.

Complete your morning at the remarkable [Unfinished Obelisk](#), where you'll gain fascinating insight into the techniques ancient Egyptian craftsmen used to carve massive granite monuments.

Return to the cruise for lunch before enjoying a leisurely afternoon onboard.

Guests may also choose to join an [optional felucca sailing trip](#) around Aswan's scenic islands or visit one of the colorful [Nubian Villages](#), where brightly painted homes, welcoming locals, and centuries-old traditions offer an authentic glimpse into Nubian culture and daily life.

Dedicated to both the great pharaoh and **Queen Nefertari**, these magnificent temples were relocated stone by stone during UNESCO's historic rescue project and remain among the world's greatest archaeological achievements.
