Day 1 | Welcome to Aswan & Begin Your Nile Journey

Your final visit takes you to the **Unfinished Obelisk**, where you'll explore the ancient granite quarries and see the largest obelisk ever attempted, still attached to the bedrock. The site offers remarkable insight into the stone-working techniques of ancient Egypt.

Return to the cruise for dinner before spending your first night on board in Aswan.

Day 2 | Sailing to Kom Ombo & Edfu

Your journey continues to the spectacular **Temple of Queen Hatshepsut**, an extraordinary monument carved into the limestone cliffs of **Deir El-Bahari**. Its elegant terraces, graceful colonnades, and detailed reliefs honor Egypt's first female pharaoh while offering magnificent views across the Theban Necropolis.

Before returning to the cruise, pause at the towering **Colossi of Memnon**, the two massive statues of Amenhotep III that have guarded this ancient landscape for thousands of years. Listen to the fascinating legends behind the famous "singing statues."

Enjoy lunch on board as the cruise begins sailing south toward Esna, passing peaceful riverside villages, lush farmland, and timeless Nile scenery. Along the way, experience the memorable passage through the Esna Lock before continuing toward Edfu.

Optional Hot Air Balloon Ride

Start your morning with an unforgettable hot air balloon flight over Luxor. As the sun rises above the Nile, you'll drift

peacefully across the Valley of the Kings, ancient temples, and green farmlands while enjoying spectacular panoramic views of ancient Thebes bathed in golden light.

Day 3 | Edfu & Kom Ombo – Two Legendary Temples
