Day 1 – Welcome to Luxor & Explore the East Bank

Visit **Karnak Temple**, the largest religious complex ever built in ancient Egypt. Wander among its towering columns, magnificent obelisks, sacred lake, and beautifully carved halls that reflect thousands of years of history. Continue to **Luxor Temple**, an elegant monument connected to Karnak by the ancient Avenue of Sphinxes. Admire its colossal statues, graceful colonnades, and impressive architecture before returning to the cruise.

Dinner and overnight on board in Luxor.

Day 2 – Royal Tombs & Sail to Esna
