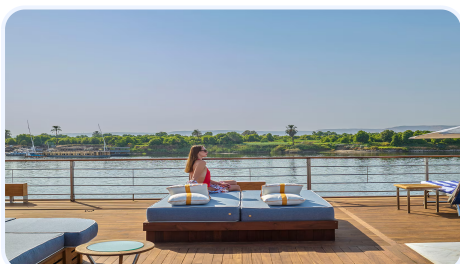

Day By Day Itinerary

Day 1

Arrival in Cairo

From the moment you arrive at **Cairo International Airport**, Egypt begins to reveal its charm. You will be welcomed by **Journey To Egypt** representative who will assist with all airport formalities and transfer you to your hotel.

Day 2

Pyramids and Sakkara Tour

Start your Egypt tour with a visit to the legendary **Pyramids of Giza**—Khufu, Khafre, and Menkaure—guarded by the iconic **Sphinx**. Marvel at the grandeur of these ancient wonders and capture the perfect photo moments.

Afterward, enjoy lunch at a local restaurant before heading to **Sakkara**, home to the **Step Pyramid of King Djoser**, the first pyramid in Egypt, created by the ingenious architect Imhotep. End your day with a visit to **Memphis**, the ancient capital, where monuments of **Ramses II** and other treasures await.

Day 3

Cairo City Highlights

Begin your second day with a tour of the **Grand Egyptian Museum**, a state-of-the-art complex showcasing over 100,000 artifacts spanning 5,000 years of history, including the treasures of **King Tutankhamun**.

Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant, then explore **Old Cairo**, visiting the **Citadel of Salah El-Din**, an architectural masterpiece with panoramic views of the city. Wander through **Khan El-Khalili**, Cairo's bustling historic bazaar, perfect for souvenirs and traditional crafts.

Day 4

Luxor East Bank and Embarkation

After breakfast, transfer to **Cairo airport** for your flight to **Luxor**. Upon arrival, transfer to your **Nile cruise** for embarkation.

In the afternoon, explore **Luxor's East Bank**, starting with the monumental **Karnak Temple Complex**, dedicated to **Amun Ra**, and the nearby **Temple of Luxor**, an iconic site reflecting ancient Theban devotion.

Evening entertainment includes an Egyptian folkloric show, followed by dinner.

Day 5

Luxor West Bank

Discover the sacred **West Bank of Luxor**, including the **Valley of the Kings**, the burial site of Pharaohs, and the remarkable **Temple of Queen Hatshepsut** at Deir El Bahari. Pause at the **Colossi of Memnon** before returning to the cruise for lunch. Afternoon at leisure as the ship sails toward Edfu.

Day 6

Edfu & Kom Ombo – Sail to Aswan

Begin your day with a visit to **Edfu Temple**, dedicated to **Horus**, one of the most well-preserved temples in Egypt. Return to the cruise for lunch while sailing to **Kom Ombo**, home to the dual **Sobek & Haroeris Temple**, showcasing ancient Egyptian religious life. Continue sailing along the scenic Nile toward **Aswan**.

Overnight on the cruise.

Day 7

Aswan City Tour

Explore Aswan, including the **High Dam**, a modern engineering marvel, followed by a boat ride to **Agilika Island** to visit the **Temple of Philae**, dedicated to the goddess **Isis**. Conclude your tour with the **Unfinished Obelisk**, carved from red granite in the ancient quarries. Return to the cruise for lunch and afternoon tea.

Overnight in Aswan

Meals Included: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 8

Abu Simbel – Back to Cairo

Early morning transfer to **Abu Simbel (about 3 hours and half driving)**, the monumental temples built by **Ramses II**, including the larger temple and the smaller temple honoring Queen **Nefertari**. After exploring, transfer to **Aswan airport** for your flight back to **Cairo**. Upon arrival, you will be transferred to your hotel.

Meals Included: Breakfast, Lunch

Day 9

Islamic and Coptic Cairo

Experience Cairo's religious heritage, starting with **Ahmed Ibn Tulun Mosque**, **Sultan Hassan Mosque**, and **El Refai Mosque**, before lunch at a local restaurant. In the afternoon, explore **Coptic Cairo**, including the **Hanging Church**, **Church of St. Sergius (Abu Serga)**, and the historic **Ben Ezra Synagogue**.

Day 10

Alexandria Day Trip

Travel north to Alexandria, Egypt's historic Mediterranean city. Begin with the **Library of Alexandria**, then visit the **Roman Amphitheatre** and **Pompey's Pillar**. Conclude with a photo stop at **Sultan Qaitbay Citadel**. Return to Cairo for overnight.

Day 11

Departure from Cairo

After breakfast, check out from your hotel and transfer to **Cairo International Airport** for your final departure, concluding your memorable Egypt tour.
