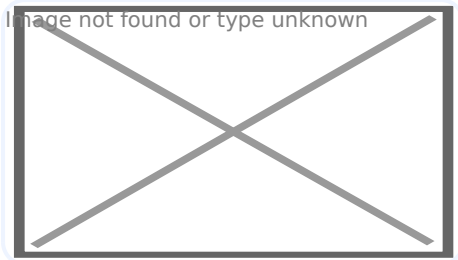

Day 1

Travel from Marsa Alam to Luxor – Discover the East Bank

Your adventure begins early in the morning as your private tour manager picks you up from your **Marsa Alam hotel** in a comfortable, air-conditioned vehicle. Enjoy scenic desert views during your drive north to **Luxor**, the timeless city once known as ancient Thebes, Egypt’s powerful capital for centuries.

Upon arrival, meet your **professional Egyptologist guide**, who will accompany you to your first awe-inspiring stop: **Karnak Temple Complex** — the largest religious structure ever built. Known in ancient times as Ipet-Isut, or “The Most Sacred of Places,” Karnak showcases over 2,000 years of construction by generations of pharaohs. Walk beneath the towering columns of the Hypostyle Hall, an unforgettable forest of massive sandstone pillars that seem to touch the sky.

Next, continue your journey through ancient history at **Luxor Temple**, built by Amenhotep III and later expanded by Ramses II. This elegant structure once hosted rituals and festivals in honor of the god Amun-Ra and remains one of the finest examples of Pharaonic architecture.

In the evening, enjoy free time in Luxor, or choose to join an **optional Sound and Light Show at Karnak Temple**, a spectacular nighttime experience that brings ancient history to life with music, narration, and dramatic lighting. You may also explore Luxor’s local market with an optional guided walking tour.

After a fulfilling day, check into your **5-star hotel in Luxor** and relax for the night.

Day 2

Explore Luxor’s West Bank – Return to Marsa Alam

After breakfast at your hotel, your journey continues to the legendary **West Bank** of the Nile, home to some of ancient Egypt’s most iconic landmarks.

Start with a brief photo stop at the towering **Colossi of Memnon**, two massive statues of Pharaoh Amenhotep III that have stood guard for over 3,000 years. Then, delve deep into the mysteries of the **Valley of the Kings**, the royal burial ground of New Kingdom pharaohs. Accompanied by your guide, you’ll explore three richly decorated tombs, each telling stories of power, religion, and the afterlife. Among them lies the tomb of King Tutankhamun, whose discovery remains one of the most important archaeological finds in history (**entry to Tut’s tomb optional**).

Next, visit the breathtaking **Temple of Queen Hatshepsut**, one of Egypt’s most unique monuments. This terraced sanctuary,

carved into the cliffs of El Deir El Bahari, was built for the only female pharaoh who ruled Egypt with unmatched power and grace.

Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant, followed by some leisure time. If you're feeling adventurous, you can add an **optional felucca sail to Banana Island**, a peaceful retreat on the Nile surrounded by lush palm groves and banana plantations.

In the late afternoon, begin your return drive to Marsa Alam, where your unforgettable 2-day Luxor trip concludes.
