Day 2

Day 3

Lunch will be served at a local restaurant.

After lunch, continue to **Old Cairo** to visit the **Citadel of Salah El-Din**. Conclude the day at **Khan El Khalili Bazaar**, one of the Middle East’s oldest and most vibrant markets. Day 4

Alexandria City Tour

End your visit with a stop at the impressive **Citadel of Sultan Qaitbay** (viewed from outside), a 15th-century fortress built on the site of the legendary Lighthouse of Alexandria, one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World.
