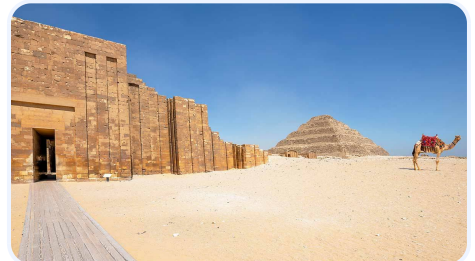

Day By Day Itinerary

Day 1

Arrival in Cairo – Standing Before the Pyramids
