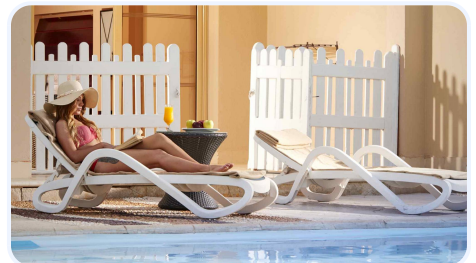
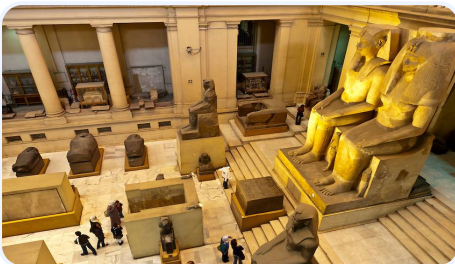
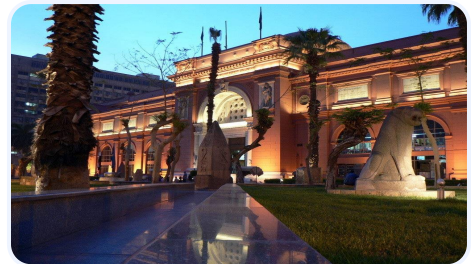

Day By Day Itinerary

Day 1

Arrival in Cairo

Upon arrival at **Cairo International Airport**, you will be met and **assisted by our representative**, who will help you through the arrival formalities before escorting you to your hotel in Cairo in a private air-conditioned vehicle. Overnight in Cairo

Meals: No meal.

Day 2

Giza Pyramids & Egyptian Museum

After breakfast in the hotel, you will be escorted by our expert tour guide to the **Grand Egyptian Museum**. There you will explore treasures of Tutankhamun and all the ancient Egypt. After that we will move to worldwide famous **Great Pyramids** of **Cheops, Chefren** and **Mykerinus**, explore magnificent **statue of Sphinx** and visit **Valley of Temple**. Lunch will be served in one of local restaurants, Then visit **Khan El Khalili Bazaars**. In the end of the day, you will be transferred to the hotel of your stay. Overnight in Cairo.

Day 3

Fly to Sharm El Sheikh

Breakfast, **Departure by flight to Sharm El-Sheikh**. Arrival, meet & assist by our local representatives and transfer to the hotel. Overnight in Sharm.

Meals: Breakfast and dinner.

Day 4

A Day at Ras Mohammed Park

Free day in Sharm or join our **optional tour to Ras Mohammed National Park** which is both a terrestrial and an aquatic nature reserve. The 480 square kilometre protected area lies where the Gulf of Suez meets the Gulf of Aqaba in Sinai's southern extremity. The arid desert terrain of sand dunes, gravel plains, fossilized corals and granite mountains is home to a number of rare mammal species: Dorcas gazelle, Nubian ibex and red fox. Easier to spot are the resident birds like terns, herons, gulls and ospreys. Thousands of white storks pass through Ras Mohammed each year, heading south during September/October and back north during April/May. About 85 flora species live in the park, including mangroves. Overnight in Sharm.

Meals: Breakfast and dinner.

Day 5

St. Catherine Monastery Tour

Free day in Sharm or join our **optional tour to The Monastery of St. Catherine** located at the heart of Sinai and at the foot of the Gebel Musa, or Mount Moses. Fronted by gardens and cypress trees, the monastery is owned and run by the Greek Orthodox Church. Its rich library houses the world's second largest collection of illuminated manuscripts after the Vatican. You can see the Burning Bush and a large number of antique works of art: invaluable icons, beautifully carved doors, exquisite wall paintings and other fine religious ornaments. Overnight in Sharm.

Meals: Breakfast and dinner.

Day 6

Flight Back to Cairo

Breakfast, Departure by **flight to Cairo**. Arrival, meet & assist by our local representatives and transfer to the hotel.

Free day or join our **optional tour to Sakkara** Including a visit to the **step Pyramids of Sakkara** (The first proper Pyramids built for the king Zoser, it is considered evolution of the Pyramid from the simple Mastaba to the Pyramid in its known form) Followed by a visit to **The Pyramids of Unas & Oser-Kaf the Mastaba . Tomb of Mereruka, Ti & Pta-Hotep** (carved and painted tombs) Then Memphis the ancient capital of Egypt where Colossal Statue of Ramses II and the great Alabaster Sphinx. Overnight in Cairo.
