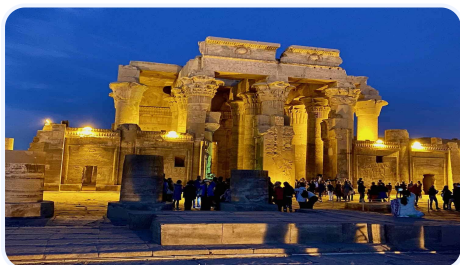
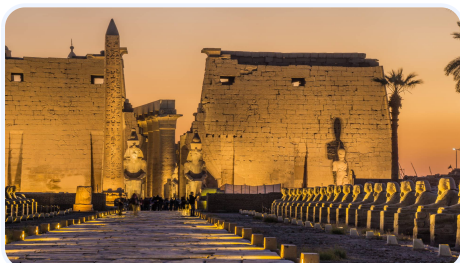

Day By Day Itinerary

Day 1

Saturday-10 October 2026 09:55 pm (UA 7718)- Arrival Cairo- Welcome To Egypt

Your representative will meet and assist you at Cairo International Airport (**Before the immigration counters, holding a sign with your name**) and provide you with an entry visa for Egypt and then he will escort you to your hotel by exclusive air-conditioned deluxe vehicle. **Overnight in Cairo. No meal.**

Day 2

Sunday -11 October 2026 Fly Cairo To Luxor

Check out from your hotel in Cairo in the morning, and then get transferred to Cairo Airport for your flight to Luxor. **Arrive Luxor Airport**, Where you are met by your Tour Guide and begin your day of exploring The **West Bank** and the Necropolis of Thebes, and view the **Colossi of Memnon**. Next, arrive at the architecturally stunning **Temple of Hatshepsut**, ancient Egypt's first female pharaoh and regarded today as one of its most successful. Continue to the **Valley of the Kings**, burial ground of the pharaohs and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. For a period of 500 years beginning in the 16th century BC, tombs were built along this valley for pharaohs and nobles, **including that of "the boy king," Tutankhamun**. **Have lunch at local restaurant**, **Transfer to your hotel in Luxor**. After, visit the striking **Temple of Luxor**. **Overnight in Luxor**. **Meals: Breakfast and Lunch**.

Day 3

Monday 12 October 2026 Luxor - Esna- Embark your Dahabiya Cruise

Enjoy breakfast at your hotel, Visit the **Temple of Karnak**, where generations of pharaohs wished to record their names. Walk through the Great Hypostyle Hall, strolling among its expertly aligned columns, which soar to 80 feet high. Later, **Transfer to Esna**, **Embark the Dahabiya Nile Cruise** and **set sail towards El Hegz Village**, where a warm welcome awaits you. Dine under the stars as you connect with a local family, immersing yourself in the rich culture of the Nile Valley. **Meals Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner**.

Day 4

Tuesday 13 October 2026 EL KAB & EDFU TEMPLE

Wake up to the gentle sway of the Nile and a delightful breakfast onboard. **Dock at El Kab**, an ancient city home to well-preserved New Kingdom tombs and the Temple of Nekhbet. Wander through these historic sites, tracing the legacies of noble officials. Back onboard, enjoy a leisurely lunch as we sail to **Edfu Temple**, one of the best-preserved temples in Egypt, dedicated to the falcon-headed god Horus. Delve into its fascinating myths and explore the nearby Tell Edfu ruins. Savor dinner onboard as we continue our tranquil journey along the Nile. **Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner**

Day 5

Wednesday 14 October 2026 BISAW VILLAGE & EL SILSELA QUARRY

After breakfast, step off at **Bisaw Island** for a morning stroll through the village. Observe traditional fishing techniques and join a local family for a bread-making session – a genuine connection with life along the Nile. Following lunch, **sail to El Silsela Quarry**, the ancient source of sandstone for Egypt's grand temples. **Visit the Speos of Horemheb, adorned with rock-cut shrines and carved stelae.** As the sun sets, indulge in a barbecue dinner under the moonlight on the riverbank. **Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner**

Day 6

Thursday 15 October 2026 KOM OMBO, DARAW MARKET & NUBIAN VILLAGE

Sail to Kom Ombo to **visit the unique double temple dedicated to Sobek and Horus**. Discover the fascinating **Crocodile Museum**, showcasing mummified crocodiles and ancient artifacts. Continue to **Daraw Market**, where you'll experience the bustling atmosphere of a traditional camel market. Wander through stalls of spices, textiles, and local produce. In the afternoon, visit a **Nubian Village** to learn about the distinctive culture and hospitality of Nubian communities. Farewell dinner onboard as we sail towards Aswan. **Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner**

Day 7

Friday 16 October 2026 DISEMBARKATION IN ASWAN - Fly back to Cairo

Early Morning:

Disembark from your Dahabiya boat in Aswan and set out on an unforgettable early-morning journey to **Abu Simbel** by private air-conditioned vehicle (**approximately 3.5 hours each way**). Visit the awe-inspiring temples of Abu Simbel, masterpieces of ancient Egyptian engineering carved into solid rock and dedicated to Ramses II and Queen Nefertari.

Price: USD 130 per person (round trip by private car).

Later in the Day:

Return to Aswan and continue your sightseeing with a visit to the impressive **Aswan High Dam**, a modern engineering marvel that reshaped Egypt's economy and controlled the flow of the Nile. Proceed to the beautiful **Philae Temple**, dedicated to the goddess Isis, set on a picturesque island and accessed by motorboat.

After completing the visits, you will be transferred to **Aswan Airport** for your domestic flight to Cairo. Upon arrival in Cairo, transfer to your hotel.

Overnight: Cairo

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch.

Day 8

Saturday 17 October 2026 Egyptian Museum | Pyramids & Sphinx

This morning, join your expert tour guide for an exploration of the **Egyptian Museum of Antiquities** to view its huge collection of ancient Egyptian artifact. Then, roam the **Giza Plateau**, site of the pyramids of Mycerinus and Chephren as well as the **Great Pyramid**. Built in the Fourth Dynasty (approximately 2690 BC), it is the **only survivor of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World**. View the **Great Sphinx** backdropped by the pyramids, a setting that has captured the imaginations of adventurers for centuries. **Meals:** Breakfast, Lunch.

Sunday 18 October 2026 Final Departure- Leave Cairo at 10:30 am (UA 7717)

Transfer to Cairo Airport for your final departure. Meals: Breakfast .

NB: "Dahabiya Journey Itinerary may change in sequence but not in visits" Alcohol Policy: Alcohol is not served onboard, but guests may bring their own, with refrigeration and glassware provided.
