Day 1

Day 2

Day 6

Marvel at the engineering marvel of the **Aswan High Dam**, which tamed the unpredictable Nile and created Lake Nasser, one of the largest artificial lakes in the world.

In the afternoon, transfer to **Aswan Airport** for your return flight to Cairo, where you will be met and escorted to your hotel for a final evening in Egypt.
