Day 2

Pyramids of Giza, Sakkara & Memphis

Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant before traveling to **Sakkara**, home of the **Step Pyramid of King Djoser**, the world's first monumental stone structure designed by the legendary architect **Imhotep**. Continue to **Memphis**, Egypt's ancient capital, where colossal statues of **Ramses II** stand beneath the open sky.

Day 3

The Egyptian Museum & Citadel – Fly to Luxor

After lunch, explore the medieval **Citadel of Salah El-Din**, once Cairo's seat of power, and admire the elegant **Alabaster Mosque of Mohamed Ali** with sweeping city views.

Day 4

Luxor's East & West Banks – Temples and Tombs of Thebes

Day 5

Temples of Edfu & Kom Ombo – Aswan Highlights

Continue to **Kom Ombo**, a remarkable dual temple devoted to **Horus the Elder** and **Sobek**, the crocodile god of fertility. Explore the site's ancient medical carvings and the Crocodile Museum nearby before driving onward to **Aswan**.

After lunch, visit the **High Dam**, Egypt's modern engineering triumph, and board a motorboat to **Philae Temple** — a serene island sanctuary dedicated to the goddess **Isis**, rescued from flooding and beautifully relocated to Agilkia Island.

Day 6

Abu Simbel Temples – Return to Cairo

An early morning departure takes you on a breathtaking drive to **Abu Simbel**, the crown jewel of ancient Nubia. These colossal rock-cut temples, built by **Ramses II**, were carved from the mountainside over 3,000 years ago — a testament to divine kingship and eternal love.

Stand in awe before the Great Temple of Ramses II and the smaller yet exquisite Temple of **Queen Nefertari**, his beloved wife. Afterward, return to Aswan and fly back to Cairo, where your incredible 6-day Egypt adventure comes to a close.
