Your local expert tour guide will share the history of these ancient royal burial grounds as you step inside 3 of the most magnificently decorated tombs carved deep into the desert rock. Continue your West Bank journey at the breathtaking Temple of Queen Hatshepsut at El Deir El Bahary, a stunning architectural masterpiece dedicated to Egypt's most powerful female pharaoh.

After completing your West Bank tour, cross the Nile to enjoy a delicious lunch at a quality local restaurant. In the afternoon, explore the grand East Bank as your guide leads you into the massive Karnak Temple complex. As the largest ancient religious site ever built, its historic name Ipet-isut translates to "the most sacred of places." Walk through the awe-inspiring Great Hypostyle Hall, an incredible forest of 134 giant sandstone pillars erected by generations of pharaohs.
